

# 7 Ways To Use a Major Scale Part 6

Play the major scale on the b3 of a minor triad. Play C major over an A minor triad.

Musical notation for exercise 1: A minor triad (A2, C3, E3) followed by the C major scale (C4, D4, E4, F4, G4, A4, B4, C5) in 4/4 time.

Play the major scale on the b3 of a minor 7th chord. Play C major over A minor 7.

Musical notation for exercise 2: A minor 7th chord (A2, C3, E3, G3) followed by the C major scale (C4, D4, E4, F4, G4, A4, B4, C5) in 4/4 time.

Play the Eb major scale over a C minor triad.

Musical notation for exercise 3: C minor triad (C3, Eb3, Gb3) followed by the Eb major scale (Eb3, F3, G3, Ab3, Bb3, C4, D4, Eb4) in 4/4 time.

Play the Eb major scale over C minor 7.

Musical notation for exercise 4: C minor 7th chord (C3, Eb3, Gb3, Bb3) followed by the Eb major scale (Eb3, F3, G3, Ab3, Bb3, C4, D4, Eb4) in 4/4 time.
